

Best Practices

Utah Compose provides a robust platform for teachers to customize, manage, and deliver individualized writing instruction.

Integration

- Partner with a content-area or ELA teacher to allow for cross-curricular collaboration while providing students with opportunities to write for different purposes and in different contexts as well as reinforcement of skills and information in both areas.
- Add ESL and special programs teachers to courses to offer support, feedback and/or scoring for special-needs students.

Differentiation

- Assign students different scoring levels within the same course to provide challenge for gifted students and scaffolding for ESL or IEP students.
- Encourage ESL or special programs teachers to provide comments, sticky notes, messages, and other feedback throughout the writing process.
- Use the “Recommended Prompts” feature to assign different prompts and/or stimulus material to differentiate for students within the same course.
- Show students how to locate and use the accessibility options, including the ability to add overlays, change background and text color, use a line reader, and change font size.
- Provide earphones for students who need lessons read aloud.



Assignments

- Balance writing assignments among the three writing genres: argumentative, informative/explanatory, and narrative.
- Align prepackaged prompts with regular instruction or create new prompts.
- Increase the complexity of the assignment and incorporate reading skills by adding stimulus material in the form of videos, webpages, articles, graphics, etc.
- Share prompts with other teachers to provide students with a wider variety of options for writing.
